Course

Old Testament Introduction A

Content:

This course is the first in a series of two units (Introduction to the Old Testament A and Introduction to the Old Testament B), which covers the basic content of the Old Testament. Old Testament A deals with the books of Genesis to 2 Kings (the first half of the Old Testament). The purpose of the unit is to provide an overview of the geographical, cultural, historical, literary and theological perspectives of the Pentateuch and the historical books. The unit focuses on the content and theological themes of the Bible and explains key issues related to hermeneutics, theology and ethics. It also explores the importance of the Old Testament for contemporary Christian life and ministry.
